

# Important

**30 responses** is the minimum number of required responses for a school report.

In order to get a full school report 30+ responses are needed per question covered in the report. The breakdown of how this works is covered on pages 5-8.

Note: If pupils miss / do not answer some questions, even though 30+ responses as a whole for the school may be logged, it may not be possible to report on every metric and so a limited school report would be produced.

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Due to Covid-19, the number was reduced to **25 responses**.

A decision will be taken during each term as to whether to reduce this to 25 responses. If this applies, the cut-off will be 25 responses instead of 30 responses.

# School report requirements

**30+ responses**

**Full / limited school report**

More than 30 responses are needed per question covered in the report. If pupils miss / do not answer some questions, even though 30+ responses as a whole for the school may be logged, it may not be possible to report on every metric and so a limited school report would be produced. **Fewer than 30 responses**

**Small school report**

**Sport England to send by email directly to the school the term after completion**

Applicable for schools who fall just short of 30 responses, including schools with very few pupils who find it harder to reach this threshold. A minimum of 10 responses are needed per question to present the data. Due to low response numbers, the data is presented as numbers rather than percentages.

# Healthy Schools Rating Scheme



The Healthy Schools Rating Scheme (HSRS) score is based solely on responses to the teacher survey.

The HSRS certificate is only provided as part of a school report and therefore schools will only receive their rating if sufficient pupil responses are received to qualify for a school report.

# Year 1-2

For a full report, the school would need:

## Behavioural data

*Need:* 30+ responses from Year 1-2 parents

## Attitudinal data

*Need:* 30+ responses from Year 1-2 pupils

Example responses achieved:

# Year 1-6

For a full report, the school would need:

## Behavioural data

*Need:* 30+ responses from Year 1-6

- 30+ responses from Year 3-6 pupils; or
- Combined 30+ responses from Year 3-6 pupils and from parents of Year 1-2

## Attitudinal data (Year 1-2)

*Need:* 30+ responses from Year 1-2 pupils

## Attitudinal data (Year 3-6)

*Need:* 30+ responses from Year 3-6 pupils

*Need: 30+ responses from Year 7-11 parents*

# Year 1-11 or any combination not already covered

For a full report, the school would need:

## Behavioural data

*Need:* 30+ responses from Year 1-11

- 30+ responses from Year 3-11 pupils; or
- Combined 30+ responses from Year 3-11 pupils and from parents of Year 1-2

## Attitudinal data (Year 1-2)

*Need:* 30+ responses from Year 1-2 pupils
